ROSETTES

The world of Carpathian Rosettes - activities for preserving the cultural uniqueness of the Carpathians

The Carpathians picturesque land of mountains and pastures is inhabited by various ethnic groups, such as Hutsuls, Boykos, Lemkos, Pogorzans, Dolinians. All these communities have been strongly influencing the surroundings, shaping local culture and traditions. The Carpathians are however divided not only ethnographically but first of all by the state borders what constraints the creation of a comprehensive vision how to effectively use the potential of their cultural and historic heritage.

One of the answers to that challenge is the ROSETTES project which aims at making the region more attractive for tourists and preventing erasing traces of cultural heritage. ROSETTES involves as many as 11 partners from Poland and Ukraine gathered to jointly preserve the traditions, crafts, customs, music and architecture of the region. Due to achieve the project's objectives, it is planned to create a Carpathian Centre Rosette, composed of 4 centers: the Carpathian Institute in Bystre (PL), the Centre of Boyko People in Urych (UA), the Kolochava Centre (UA) and the Carpathian Cultural Centre in Kosiv (UA). The centre will organize crafts workshops, seminars, exhibitions, media events promoting the Carpathians and culture of their inhabitants. Second crucial part of the project is an archivisation of records related to the Carpathians history and heritage. So the legacy and relics are preserved for the future generations.

The ROSETTES outcomes will benefit firstly the ethnic groups inhabiting the Carpathians, local communes and tourists visiting this region. The elaborated solution to involve local communities in the management of cultural and historic assets will help to preserve the heritage and shall be the base for further actions within four created centres.
