The Roztocze region, with its unique geography and nature, requires cross-border activities which could boost its recognition. Situated across the Polish-Ukrainian border, it is a multicultural area with great biodiversity, very valuable in terms of nature. However, both Polish and Ukrainian sides are aware of low ecological awareness, poor technical condition of tourist infrastructure and lack of adequate promotion of the Roztocze brand. Now the tourist services are not standardized and tourism is not subjected to cohesive Polish-Ukrainian promotion which could make the Roztocze brand more recognizable.

The overall objective of the project is promotion and preservation of natural heritage through improving tourist infrastructure, creating tourist products leading to strengthening partnership and improving the image and attractiveness of the Polish and Ukrainian Roztocze. The expected changes resulting from this project are better tourist infrastructure, reduction of environmental degradation, introduction of spatial order in adjacent areas, building the accompanying infrastructure and enhancing the tourist potential of the area.

Poor knowledge of tourist attractions, cultural and historical heritage of Sokolka and Grodno County, lack of tourist infrastructure, including marked bike trails and monuments along with the accompanying infrastructure, as well as poor condition of the historic buildings in the regions are things to be tackled by the project. Activities of the project will contribute to renovation and furnishing the historic buildings in Sokółka and Grodno, creation and marking of the cross-border tourist route "Tyzenhauz Trail" Sokółka-Grodno. Equipment of the tourist route with the new bikes will help with discovering and promotion of the region as well as will organize the cross-border bike rallies. Finally, the Tourist Information Point (TIP) in Sokółka will be established as well TIP in Grodno will be retrofitted.

Historic buildings renovated within the project and added to the registry of monuments will be earmarked for cultural, educational and tourism purposes. The TIPs created and retrofitted in the Partners regions will provide comprehensive range of tourist services. Tourist infrastructure will be developed along the border area and a joint tourist offer will be created. Additionally, it will increase citizens awareness of the potential of the area, which in turn will increase the interest in the region on both sides of the border, being considered a tourist attraction, also it will create conditions for the further development of tourist services. The investment works will be supported by the soft activities as creation of the strategy for the development of cross-border tourism, organization of joint 15 events, wide range of project promotion.



The river Bug, still unregulated, meanders through diversified landscape and gently shaped hills. The new tourism product will offer 800 km of kayak trails, properly marked and filled with facilities needed for active leisure and viewpoints to observe unique scenery.

Centers of tourism, created within the project, will work as a spot for enhancing cross-border tourism. International crossborder events will enable the communities to strengthen the cooperation and create new contacts. An extensive advertising campaign will allow to promote the regions and its natural treasures and the new opportunities for tourist activities.

The Tanew River flows through the territory of the Commune Ksiezpol. The Bug River is flowing through the territory of the Ukrainian partner. Every year the state of water in both rivers is getting worse by excessive discharge of sewage and by outdated wastewater treatment facilities. Preserving the natural heritage for future generations in their area by improving wastewater management is the main aim of the project. Implementation of the project will greatly improve the living conditions of the inhabitants of Commune Ksiezpol and the town Chervonograd.

The overall aim of the project KSICHER is to protect the natural heritage by prevention of pollution of rivers flowing through nature and landscape protection areas. Municipal sewage treatment plant in the commune Ksiezpol will be modernized and a sewage system with a length of about 10 km will be constructed. The infrastructure will collect sewage from towns located in close proximity to the river Tanew and Natura. Municipal sewage treatment plant in Chervonograd will be modernized and thanks to that the Bug River will be protected from pollution.



The touristic movement around cross-border area of Gmina Puchaczow (PL) and Lyahovichy District (BY) doesn't correspond to their touristic potential due i.a. to insufficient touristic popularity, quality of infrastructure and tourist offer, including utilizing cultural heritage resources. The result of such situation is insufficient utilization of cultural heritage and unused common heritage, caused by limited capabilities of using of culture for tourism development.

The overall aim of project ROCCO is increase of involving of cultural heritage potential of Gmina Puchaczow and Lyahovichy District for development of cross-border tourism. The project includes i.a. renovation of two historical manors (Lachert Manor in Ciechanki(PL) and Reytans Manor in Grushevka (BY)). The Carpathians used to be a magic land of pastures, mountains and shepherds. The area's cultural heritage was created by Hutsuls, Boykos, Lemkos, Pogorzans, Dolinians. The ongoing process of changes, including process of unification of local cultures in Europe, has caused the extinction of local cultures, traditions and crafts, both in Poland and in Ukraine. On both sides of the border, it is possible to witness the lack of a complex vision how to use cultural and historic heritage, although common cultural heritage is one of the most significant assets of the region.

The overall objective of the project is to preserve heritage of the Carpathians (traditions, craft, customs, music, architecture) through specific objectives: development of cross-border cooperation in the management of cultural and historical resources of the Carpathians through creating a network of organizations which undertake actions in this field, promotion of the knowledge of regional traditions, practices and action aimed at restoration of craft skills and through enhancing competences of selected local communities in the cultural management of the region.

The main purpose of the project is protection of the Solina Lake and Schodnica waters from contamination with sewage and also maintain a good quality surface and groundwater as the main natural resources used by tourists and patients. Due to underdeveloped wastewater management in both regions pollution is undoubtedly the biggest problem in the project partners regions. Increasing the number of hotels, recreation centers and new residential buildings creates a greater need for wastewater infrastructure. Therefore, within the project both partners are going to construct the sewage treatment plants and sanitary sewage system in Schidnica (UA) – 2 buildings, and construction of the sanitary sewage system in Solina Commune (PL) – 7926 m.

The result of the investments will be connection to the sewage system of the 105 buildings on the Polish side and 86 buildings on the Ukrainian side, including 8 large hotels. Construction of sewage treatment plants and sanitary sewage system will reduce pollution inputs directly into the soil, surface water and deep water. Also it will create the opportunity for the development of tourism in the region and increase its attractiveness to foreign investors. Moreover, widely expanded promotion of the project (publications, promotional films, joint events etc.) is planned within the project.

Unfortunately, the Lasosna and Yaselda rivers are being polluted since the current treatment technologies used in the existing waste water plants are energy- and capital-intensive. Moreover, ecology awareness of citizens needs to be raised and tourists need to be encouraged to visit these regions, because tourism potential of these locations is still untapped. Thus, the purpose of the project is to change this negative trends in order to improve attractiveness of both locations for citizens and tourists.

The project partners will modernize the water treatment plants in Kuźnica (Poland) and Bereza (Belarus), while the insufficient old technologies will be replaced by modern ones in order to protect environment better. At the same time, a campaign "Think eco" for communities on both sides of the border will be organised to raise the ecological awareness. The partner will also exchange experiences on the environmental management and international projects implementation.
