





# CROSS-BORDER EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN FOR SCHOOLS WITHIN EUROPEAN COOPERATION DAY 2020 "TOGETHER FOR GREENER TOMORROW!"

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Cross-border Cooperation Programme Poland - Belarus - Ukraine 2014-2020 invites schools from the Programme area (<a href="https://www.pbu2020.eu/en/pages/192">https://www.pbu2020.eu/en/pages/192</a>) to take part in the Cross-border Educational Campaign within European Cooperation Day 2020. Today the issues of preserving our planet are of crucial importance, therefore the slogan of the educational campaign this year is TOGETHER FOR GREENER TOMORROW!

### THE IDEA

24 selected teams from Poland, Belarus and Ukraine (8 teams per country) will be invited to meet together and take part in the Final Event on 17-20<sup>th</sup> September 2020 in Brest (Belarus). Then, during the games, workshops and other activities, the participants from three countries will cooperate in mixed cross-border international teams. The teenagers will have the opportunity to demonstrate their creativity, skills and knowledge as well as make new friends and have exciting experiences of working in common with the aim to preserve our joint cross-border nature!

Teenagers from border areas of Poland, Belarus and Ukraine will meet together and develop useful environmental lifestyle skills and abilities for having a "Greener Tomorrow".

Each participant will be awarded with unique promotional EU and Programme materials and gadgets. The organizers will provide travel, accommodation and catering for all 24 selected teams.

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

**4-student teams** from schools (including comprehensive secondary schools, art and music schools):

- in Poland: from Podlaskie, Lubelskie and Podkarpackie voivodeships as well as from the eastern part of the Mazowieckie Voivodeship (Ostrołęka-Siedlce Subregion);
- in Belarus: from Grodno, Brest, Minsk and Gomel Oblasts;
- in Ukraine: Volyn, Lviv, Zakarpattya, Rivne, Ternopil and Ivano-Frankivsk Oblasts.

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Students **aged 12-16** (not graduating classes). The team must be accompanied by one teacher (head of the team). **Each school can submit only one application.** 

## **HOW TO PARTICIPATE**

## Step 1

Each school shall delegate a team and fulfill the tasks indicated in the application form.

## Step 2

- 1. Fill in the application form and parental/legal guardian's consents, attach the needed annexes.
- 2. Send it
  - by ordinary mail/courier AND
  - by e-mail (video-files, pictures, drawings, texts etc.). Large files eg. movies should be sent as links.

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The deadline for submission of BOTH (paper and electronic) applications is **8**<sup>th</sup> **May 2020** (date of receipt of documents in the relevant Branch Office). The e-applications must be sent to the e-mail of the corresponding Branch Office **till 14:00** (of local time) on **8**<sup>th</sup> **May 2020**.

Submissions received after that date will not be taken into account.

Step 3

By 18<sup>th</sup> May, the organizers will select the best teams from each country. The ranking list will be based on the score results. Priority will be given for the schools taking part in the contest for the first time additional points by assessment).

The teams from Poland will be assessed and selected by the Polish Branch Office, the teams from Belarus by the Belarusian Branch Office, and the teams from Ukraine by the Ukrainian Branch Office. **The list of selected teams will be published on the Programme website <a href="www.pbu2020.eu">www.pbu2020.eu</a> on 19<sup>th</sup> May. Step 4

Selected teams will be officially invited to take part in the Final Event (17-20<sup>th</sup> September 2020, Brest, Belarus) and they must **confirm their participation by the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2020**.

Step 5

17-20<sup>th</sup> September 2020, Brest (Belarus) – the Final Event starts!
