3. Assumptions for a schedule of projects submission, selection, contracting

- LIPs

o Direct award

Duration: max 30 months

REGULAR PROJECTS

Selected via calls

Grant value 200 000 – 2 500 000 EUR

o Duration: max 24 months

- MICROPROJECTS

Selected via calls, 2 options possible:

Calls organized by the JS (model as in 2014-2020)

SPF

Grant value 50 000 – 100 000 EUR

Duration: max 12 months

ACCENT ON FAST CERTIFICATION

 Due to 21-27 system of Interreg programmes' financing, which is based on the certified expenditures, the precedence for the MA is to ensure the fastest certification of large portion of the Programme budget.

Call 1

Estimated number of proposals: 200

- Call 1 will be opened to Priorities ENVIRONMENT and HEALTH the most urgent themes considering situation in the Programme area.
- Call 1 will be announced in May 2023 and will be open until 31 July 2023. Proposals will be submitted simultaneously for both priorities. However, the project proposals under the priority HEALTH will be assessed and selected first, and the assessment and selection of the project proposals under the priority ENVIRONMENT will follow after. Consequently, two meetings of the MC will be organised.

o Call 2

- Estimated number of proposals: 200
- Call 2 will be opened to Priorities TOURISM and COOPERATION.
- The precedence in Call 2 schedule shall be contracting as many projects as possible in 2024.

Calls 3 and 4

- Estimated number of proposals: 200 / each
- Since allocation for microprojects consumes only 6% of the whole Programme allocation for projects and these are the shortest, 12 months projects, they will be selected as the last ones, after LIPs / regular projects, leaving them still enough time for successful completion.
